

1.0 POLICY:

This tuition policy is applicable to all Metro Technology Centers, d/b/a Metro Tech, courses except those courses offered through the Aviation Career Center program, the Adult Health Occupation programs, and the Nail/Facial and Cosmetology programs.

It is both the intent and the policy of the Board of Education to provide career and technology education and skills training to all patrons of Metro Tech at the most affordable rates possible.

High school students enrolled at participating district high schools pay no tuition. High school students enrolled in other school districts within Oklahoma County may enroll in a Metro Tech program in accordance with the provisions of the county-wide reciprocity agreement.

Tuition and/or fees for adult day-time students, short-term adult students, industry-specific training and other services performed by the District, requiring an enrollment fee, shall be determined by the superintendent and his/her staff. The superintendent shall advise the Board of any change to the enrollment fee schedule at the next regularly scheduled meeting following any such change.

All Oklahoma residents shall pay the same rate of tuition for attending adult education programs at Metro Technology Centers; provided that scholarship and tuition waiver students shall not be subject to this paragraph.
