1.0 POLICY:

It is the policy of the Board of Education that Metro Technology Centers School District No.22 d/b/a Metro Tech, be in compliance with applicable Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 14 Part 65 and Part 147 at all times in all phases of the certified maintenance technician curriculum. Board Policy takes precedence for all policies and procedures unless it conflicts with the CFR 14. Where a conflict occurs, the Code of Federal Regulations shall take precedence. Should CFR 14 and Board Policies conflict, the Superintendent shall be notified and will bring the situation to the Board Policy Committee for resolution. If necessary, the Superintendent is empowered to issue interim school policy to prevent certification issues.

Metro Technology Centers conducts aircraft maintenance training and education as authorized by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and documented on FAA Form 8310-6. Metro Technology Centers operates under Air Agency Certificate Number BE9T031R. Training and operations are contained in the FAA-approved Operational Procedure Manual (OPM). The OPM is an electronic document stored on-line and is available to all faculty and staff for review and consultation.
